- The ETFA Executive will support all decisions of the Executive regardless of their own feelings about a decision.
- Members of the ETFA Executive will bring all concerns and issues forward to the ETFA President or Vice President to be addressed with the whole Executive.
- The ETFA Executive will abide by all laws, statutes and bylaws that govern our league.
